ZABS is a registered private voluntary organization whose main objective is to combat stigma, marginalization, bullying and exclusion of children and youths living with disabilities in vulnerable communities in Zimbabwe. ZABS IN ACTION...

Over the past three months, the Zimbabwe Anti-Bullying Society (ZABS) has continued to strengthen its commitment to protecting children, promoting inclusion, and empowering vulnerable communities across Zvimba Rural District. Our outreach team has conducted anti-bullying awareness campaigns in schools and surrounding communities, engaging learners, teachers, parents, and community leaders in conversations about preventing bullying and creating safe, respectful, and inclusive learning environments. These sessions have helped raise awareness of the harmful effects of bullying while encouraging communities to work together to protect children with disabilities.

ZABS NUTRITION GARDEN

Alongside our advocacy work, ZABS has continued to provide practical support to vulnerable families facing economic hardship. One of our recent milestones has been the establishment of a community nutrition garden, where vegetables such as tomatoes, onions, cucumbers, potatoes, and leafy greens are cultivated. The harvest is shared with vulnerable households, improving household nutrition while promoting community participation and resilience.



Preparing Youth for Sustainable Livelihoods

ZABS is also laying a strong foundation for expanding livelihood opportunities through practical vocational skills training. Beginning in August 2026, the organization will launch a six-month Technical Skills and Livelihoods Empowerment Programme targeting youths with disabilities, out-of-school youth, and young people from marginalized communities.

The programme will offer hands-on training in:

- Clothing Technology
- Entrepreneurship
- Self-help and income-generating initiatives
- Business development and life skills

The initiative is designed to equip participants with practical skills that promote self-reliance, financial independence, and sustainable livelihoods.

Nationally Recognised Certification

Upon successful completion of the programme, participants will receive nationally recognized certificates accredited by the Higher Examinations Council of Zimbabwe (HEXCO), enhancing their opportunities for employment, self-employment, and further professional development.

As ZABS continues to grow, our vision remains clear—to build communities where every child is protected from bullying, every learner enjoys equal opportunities regardless of disability, and every young person has access to the skills and support needed to build a brighter future.
